- 2 Sailing is a weather dependant sport and every effort will be made to make bet use of the prevailing and forecast conditions at the time of the course. Only in exceptional circumstances will the club decide to reschedule a course due to weather conditions. In such circumstances every effort will be made to accommodate applicants on suitable alternative courses. The decision to sail on any course will be entirely at the discretion of the senior instructor.
- 3 Participants or their legal guardians (in the case of participants under the age of 18) agree that DHSC may take their photographs during the Training Course and may use their image on the club website or other publicity material.

Non-members are treated as Temporary Club Members for the duration of the Course Only.

USE OF OTHER BOATS

- (i) I agree to pay for any damage caused to boats or equipment where I/my child was responsible for the damage caused.
- (ii) I acknowledge that it is a condition precedent of my/my child's use of the boat that I/he/she will at all times adhere to such direction as may be given by the course instructors, course assistants, OOD, Club Officer and I acknowledge the entitlement of DHSC and the Course Administrators and instructors to exclude me/my child from participation in any aspect of the sailing session/course if it is deemed appropriate by them to do so.
- (iii) I acknowledge that in the event of an insurance claim being necessitated as a consequence of the actions, accidental or otherwise, of me/my child, that any excess not covered by an insurance policy will be discharged by me.

I fully accept that sailing can be a hazardous sport. It may involve falling out of the boat into deep water or the boat capsizing and turning over. I agree to wear a Personal Flotation Device with at least 50N of permanent buoyancy at all times while sailing.

I hereby acknowledge that DHSC, their officers, members and volunteers do not accept liability for loss of life or property, personal injury or damage caused by or arising out of this course, and that the above named sailor takes part in the course entirely at their own risk.
