

Code of Conduct for Instructors at DHSC

- Be positive during sailing sessions, be patient with young learners and praise at every opportunity
- Treat all young people, fellow instructors, Club members and parents with respect at all times.
- Listen to your students and never use bad language.
- Enjoy your work and ensure that the students learn and have fun in a safe environment
- Prepare and plan well in advance of your training sessions.
- Arrive and depart at the appropriate time.
 Those instructing in the morning session should have all boats rigged and brought down to the slip before 9.
 Those instructing in the afternoon should ensure that all boats are returned back to the dinghy yard at 6. The red boats must be filled with fuel in preparation for the morning.
- Respect all of the property of DHSC and the property of all involved in the course.
- Use the Boat logbook to report any breakages on the boats your group has been using.
- Do not remove anything from another person's boat without permission.
- Involve all students in your group in all activities
- Record and report any problem / incident which occurs while you are training. Keep the SI and the Centre Principal informed.
- Watch out for any incidents of bullying and report to the SI. Make sure that everyone (instructors and young people) is included socially.
- You must ensure that the students assigned to you are supervised by you at all times.
